

CALPERS 2023 HEALTH PLAN PREMIUMS PECG's 85%/80% Reimbursement Formula Best in State Service

E ach spring, the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) meets with the various health plan providers to negotiate premiums that take effect on January 1 of the following year. Recently, CalPERS announced that the average premium will go up 6.75% in 2023, however, rate changes vary widely from plan to plan. Last year, the average rate increase was 4.86%.

The state's contribution to your health care premium is set by PECG's current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). For Unit 9 rank and file employees, the state's contribution is based on what is

New Primary Care Provider matching for PPO basic members. miums are higher than those of the displaced plans, the change actually increases the reimbursement rates for all state employees.

The state then pays 85% of the premium amount for Unit 9 rank and file employees and 80% of the additional premium costs for their family members. This is the best health care reimbursement rate in state service. As shown in the tables on pages 2 and 3 of this Informer, in 2023, the state's monthly contribution according to the 85%/80% formula will increase by 6% to 6.5% to \$732 for employee only, \$1,429 for two-party, and \$1,827 for family coverage. If

known as the 85%/80% formula. In arriving at its reimbursement rate, the state first calculates the weighted average premium for the four plans with the highest participation by active state civil service employees. For 2023, that includes Kaiser Permanente, PERS Gold, PERS Platinum, and UnitedHealthcare Signature Alliance. PERS Gold and PERS Platinum replace Blue Shield Access+ and CCPOA South in the top four plans for 2023. Given that PERS Gold and PERS Platinum prethe premium for the plan you select is higher than that, you would then pay the difference each month. In 2022, the state's monthly contribution for Unit 9 employees was \$691 for employee only, \$1,342 for two-party, and \$1,727 for family coverage.

to your plan provider for 2023, the **open enrollment period starts on September 19 and closes on October 14, 2022**. Beginning September 12, you may log in to your my|CalP-ERS account to access customized health information and explore your 2023 health plan options.

Supervisors and managers are covered by what is known as CoBen. The state makes a contribution which the individual can then apply to health and dental premiums. For 2023, the CoBen benefit allowance is \$780 for the employee only, \$1,515 for two-party, and \$1,945 for families. To find Dental Plan rates for 2023, you may visit the CalHR website. The state pays the Vision Care premium.
