Discussion:

- Discussed section finances.

- Discussed upcoming section annual meeting. Kaylie to ask about precedence on whether section meeting should occur before or after corporate meeting.
- Discussed PECG recruiting tools website and videos. Focus on representation, pay surveys for employees to address pay discrepancies and legislative days
- Managers Notes –
 - State Attrition rate for 2020 was 8%
