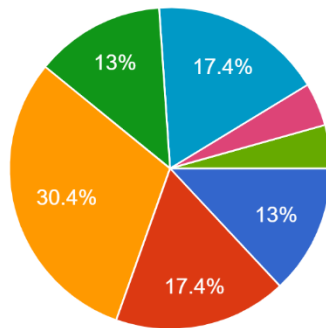




## 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Redding Section Report
